We are asking citizens to come in and assist with reducing the number of dogs in our shelter by fostering animals.

To reduce the barriers for fostering we will be changing what animals can go.

- Any red-listed dogs can go to foster. (Unless they are a rescue-only dog due to medical or behavior)
- Intact animals can go to foster if there are no intact animals in the home.
- Dogs going into foster must have a microchip and be rabies vaccinated if age appropriate.

If you consider fostering, please ask yourself:

- Do you have any other dogs? If so, are those dogs spayed/neutered?
- Will the foster dog be allowed to be an inside/outside dog? Dogs should not just be stuck out in the backyard.
- Is it the right fit for your family? Consider energy level, behavior, etc.
