

Low Cost Spay/Neuter

Stanislaus Animal Services Agency (SASA) is thrilled to offer an affordable spay/neuter option, aimed at tackling the pressing issue of pet overpopulation in Stanislaus County. Recognizing that spaying/neutering pets is the most effective solution, SASA is committed to making this vital service accessible to all pet owners, regardless of their financial constraints.

The Stanislaus County Alternative to Euthanasia (SCATE) program will provide vouchers for spay/neuter surgeries to citizens served by SASA. Pet owners can now take advantage of this opportunity and purchase a spay/neuter voucher for their dogs at the remarkably low price of \$50 or for their cats at just \$25. Vouchers are then used at participating veterinarian offices.

SASA is excited to announce that 125 vouchers will be available at this special low rate. Pet owners who wish to take advantage of this opportunity are encouraged to visit the SASA shelter located at 3647 Cornucopia Way in Modesto starting Thursday, May 18th. Please note that vouchers will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis, and only four vouchers per household, located within the SASA service area, will be issued. Citizens must reside in Modesto, Ceres, Patterson, Waterford, Hughson, or unincorporated Stanislaus County to take part in the program and must purchase the vouchers in person while supplies last.
